RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of my being permitted to participate, and/or my child or ward being permitted to participate, in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge event, a horseback riding/equine activity conducted by Friends of Lake Louisa, its officers, employees and agents, and being conducted on the premises of Lake Louisa State Park, the undersigned, hereinafter referred to as releasor, for himself/herself and his/her personal representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, assigns, and next of kin, releases, waives, discharges and covenants not to sue Friends of Lake Louisa, its officers, employees, agents and activity sponsors, owners and lessors of the premises, the Florida Park Service, Lake Louisa State Park management and personnel and event volunteers, and each of them, their officers and employees, all hereinafter referred to as releasees, from all liability to the releasor, his /her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, executors, administrators and next of kin, for all loss or damage, and any claim of damage therefore, on account of injury to person or property or resulting in death of the releasor, whether caused by the negligence of releasees or otherwise, arising out of or in any way connected with releasor's participation in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge event.

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Releasor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the releasees and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost releasees may incur due to the presence of releasor in or on the premises of Lake Louisa State Park for the purpose of participating, competing, officiating, working or for any other purpose associated with the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge event whether caused by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise.

Releasor assumes full responsibility for and risk of bodily injury, death or property damage due to negligence of releasees or otherwise while in or on the premises, and/or while competing, officiating, working or for any purpose participating in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge and related activities.

Releasor agrees that this release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida and that if any portion of this release is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance of the agreement shall; notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

Releasor, being of lawful age and/or signing on behalf of their minor child, in consideration of being permitted to participate in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge equine event does for himself/herself and his/her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns hereby release and forever discharge Friends of Lake Louisa, its officers, employees, agents and activity sponsors, owners and lessors of the premises and each of them, their officers and employees, heirs, administrators and executors of and from any and every claim, demand, action or right of action, of whatsoever kind or nature, either in law or in equity arising from or by reason of any bodily injury or personal injuries known or unknown, death and/or property damage resulting or to result from any accident which may occur as a result of participation, working, sponsoring, volunteering at the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge equine event on the premises of Lake Louisa State Park, Clermont, Florida, whether such injuries occurred because of negligence or not.

Releasor further states that he/she has carefully read the above release and knows the contents of the release and signs this release as his/her own free act.

Releasor further releases all premise owners, officials, sponsors, judges, and professional personnel from any claim whatsoever on account of first aid, treatment or medical services rendered him/her arising out of or in any way connected with participating in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge equine event.

RIDING HELMET RELEASE OF LIABILITY (FOR PARTICIPANTS OVER AGE 18) – HELMETS ARE MANDATORY FOR PARTICIPANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18

Releasor understands that a riding helmet/hard hat is an essential safety item and that he/she can possibly lessen or prevent injury to himself/herself by wearing a riding helmet/hard hat. Releasor also understands that horseback riding and related activities involve risk of injury, including the possibility of serious injury or death, and that riding without a riding helmet/hard hat increases the risk of injury or death. Releasor understands that if he/she chooses to ride without a riding helmet/hard hat he/she assumes the risk of injury and or death and that he/she is releasing Releasees, including, Friends of Lake Louisa, its officers, employees, agents and activity sponsors, owners and lessors of the premises and each of them, their officers and employees, heirs, administrators and executors from any liability for injury Releasor sustained due to failing to wear a riding helmet/hard hat.

WARNING

UNDER FLORIDA LAW, AN EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO, OR THE DEATH OF, A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES.

Releasor understands that this event involves being in a remote area, at times far from transportation and medical facilities. Releasor understands that these areas may have many natural and man-made hazards that Releasees may not anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate. Releasor understands that horses

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can be excitable, difficult to control, unpredictable and dangerous. Releasor understands that a horse may be startled by sudden movement, noise or other factors and may shy suddenly, rear, stop short, bite, buck, kick or run with its rider, especially when the ride is conducted through a natural setting, as this event will be and the Releasor assumes all risks incidental to such participation, including, but not limited to, those risks set out above, and on their own behalf and on behalf of their minor child or ward.

Releasor understands that this event includes man-made "Obstacle Challenges" that may present an increased risk of injury to the rider since horses will be faced with new and unknown obstacles that may cause even the most seasoned of horses to bolt, spook or behave in a manner that may put the rider at risk of injury.

I understand that this release and indemnity agreement includes any claims based on the negligence, actions or inaction of any of the above released parties and covers bodily injury, death and property damage, whether suffered by Releasor and or their child or ward before, during or after such participation in the 2010 Friends of Lake Louisa State Park Obstacle Trail Challenge event at the Lake Louisa State Park in Clermont, Florida.

This release is also valid for claims for damage or injury to Releasor's animals and/or personal belongings. This release applies for the entire event, from arrival, during the ride, and until the removal of all animals and personal property from the Lake Louisa State Park.
